The theme that speaks out to me in this reflection is taken from today's 2nd Reading in the Letter to the Hebrews: Those whom the Lord loves, He disciplines. El tema que resuena para me en esta reflexion se toma de la segunda lectura de hoy en la Carta a Los Hebreos. El Señor ama aquellos que El disciplina. Con esto, recordamos que durante esos tiempos difíciles en nuestras vidas cuando estamos pasando por pruebas que en las "tribulaciones, sabiendo que la prueba ejercita la paciencia, que la paciencia nos hace madurar y que la madurez aviva la esperanza, la cual no quedara frustrada..." (Romanos 5:3,4,5). Dios nunca prometio quitarnos la tentacion, porque hasta Cristo lo paso. The Biblia nos dice que "El fue probado en todas las cosas, como nosotros, menos el pecado." Entonces, recordamos, en todo tiempo de tentacion el ejemplo que El Señor nos dejo.
